- A community where people from across Europe meet, get active for democracy together, share knowledge and learn new skills


A get out the vote tool for the European elections 2024







Share knowledge and grow their skills through trainings that range from topic focused trainings (e.g. on social media skills) to major cross-border events organized yearly.

Be rewarded and celebrated for their success.



What do community members do?

- Policy Hackathons: brainstorming sessions where community members can propose ideas how to activate voters
- EU Citizenship Workshops: Host workshops to educate young adults, about the benefits and responsibilities of EU citisenship. Discuss topics such as freedom of movement, Erasmus opportunities, and cross-border collaboration.
- Civic Education Webinars: Arrange webinars that focus on educating participants about the EU's structure, decision-making processes.

- **EU Art & Poetry Contests:** Express EU perspectives through art, poetry, or short films.
- Local Integration: Collaborate with schools and cultural centers to integrate EU residents and promote cross-border friendships.
- Virtual Exchange: Connect schools and universities across EU countries for interactive learning.
- EU Youth Ambassadors: Engage youth in EU policy discussions through ambassadors.

What do community members do?

- Simulated Elections: Organise mock elections to simulate the EU voting experience.
- Trendy Social Media: Launch EU campaigns on platforms like TikTok.
- Engaging Youth Advisors: Form committees challenging students on EU awareness.
- Voter Sign-Up Initiatives: Encourage students to register and motivate peers.

- In-depth EU Debates: Host series on environmental, tech, AI, and health topics.
- Influencer Conversations: Conduct EU talks with school influencers.
- Youth-Led EU Discussions: Empower youth with debates on EU issues.
- EuroQuiz Challenges: Organize interactive quizzes testing community members' EU knowledge.
- European Language Exchanges: Facilitate language swaps to encourage cross-border communication.




