

An intensive modular course (5 to 30 EGTS) designed for training, instruction, and qualification; this comprehensive educational package enables both national and international certification and recognition of qualifications according to occupational standards. The course is conceptualized in modules that can be offered as Level 4 micro-qualifications (post-secondary, technical education) and Levels 6-7 (tertiary education, bachelor's and master's degrees).









The National Youth Agency

The National Youth Agency is an administrative authority under the Ministry of Education and Research of the Republic of Moldova, established for the training, and continuous professional improvement of youth workers, development of youth programs, youth work, research, and services in the youth field, and for their implementation, monitoring and evaluation.

The main responsibilities of the Agency are:

- coordinating the implementation of current programs in the youth sector that develops youth work;
- develop and implement a national monitoring mechanism and ensure the quality of youth services;
- development and training of human resources;
- development of various thematic studies, research and analysis in the field.

Youth worker

A person who, through youth work, supports young people in their personal, social and educational development in order to ensure their better integration into society.

Specialist in youth work

A person who has received special training in youth work and provides professional services to young people.


Youth work

Any action with and for young people, of a social, cultural, educational or civic nature, based on non-formal learning processes and voluntary participation of young people, coordinated by a youth worker or specialist in working with young people.


Working Groups


