

4.1 Main actors of voluntary activities of young people

Governmental actors

Ministry of Interior executes volunteer service legislation and manages non-governmental organizations. The Department of Associations and Organizations within the Ministry regulates the content and the procedures of the NGOs at the national and international levels. Besides the Ministry operates the local voluntary services in terms of Municipalital activities.

(www.icisleri.gov.tr) The Ministry of Health operates the voluntary services within the Turkish Red Crescent Society in a wide range in cooperation with other national and international organizations. (www.saglik.gov.tr, www.kizilay.gov.tr) Both The Prime Ministry General Directorate of Youth and Sports and the Ministry of National Education operate many youth voluntary activities.

Non governmental actors

Most of the NGOs in Turkey have voluntary services, voluntary activities and/or voluntary education programs in cooperation with the related Ministries and organizations and they take the advantages of young volunteers. Among them Community Volunteers Foundation(CVF)can be considered as the biggest. CVF has realized more than 800 local and national projects, has provided 595 trainings to its volunteers, opened 4 Youth Service Centers and 3 Local Coordination Centers, and provides 397 university students with scholarships with the active participation of young volunteers and assistance of adult volunteers so far(www.tog.org.tr). Educational Volunteers Foundation(TEGV) and their mission is to provide non-formal educational opportunities for children and youth in need, currently serving the non-formal educational needs of over 150,000 children and young people (aged 6-16) throughout Turkey. It works with up to 2,780 volunteers annually. The foundation aims to enhance personal potential, attitudes and community values in youth, by providing effective training programs for young volunteers working with less-privileged children and youth throughout Turkey, and the opportunity for young people to practise life skills by participating in non-formal mentored programs for children throughout Turkey. 5.1 Legal status of volunteers

The Ministry of Internal have a Regulation for the Voluntary Activities within Municipal Services. This regulation applies for many other voluntary activities. Volunteers can not be under the age 12 and until the age of 18, permission from the parents is required. In some cases, specific health reports is required.

Military service is obligatory in Turkey. Every 18 years old men has to register for the army as a civillian. Specific exceptions can be made such as the health problems or the educational reasons.
