Youth work & democracy

- American/French Revolution: How can free individuals live together and in the same time create a stable system?
- Industrial revolution/The social question

Private - Public

- Private: individual freedom, choice, autonomy, diversity, ...
- Public: social order, law, equality, universality, ...
- Social: managing the confrontation between the values dominant in the private and the public, between individual aspirations and public expectations

Managing the social

- Is inevitably political and pedagogical
- Central questions:
 - Which society do we (want to) live in?
 - How do we relate to each other?
 - What is my/our place in society?
 - What are social problems?
- How do we organize orientation on society? How do we interfere in socialisation of young people? Horizon?

Political and pedagogical

- Different ways to construct the relationship between private and public
- The social as a *transit-zone*: guiding young people to integrate in the social order
- The social as a *forum*: discussing the way we relate to each other and the conditions that structure those relationships

Transit (MARS)

Public sphere as starting point How to earn a living?

Pedagogy: individual pedagogy, harmonious development, guidance without dictation (BP), group work, dissociation

Politics: create social capital, social cohesion

<u>Keywords</u>: consensus, voluntaryism professionalisation, integration, institutional change, empowerment, autonomy, ...

Youth work, a social profession

- Makes youth work vulnerable to instrumentalisation
 - Either from the public sphere
 - Either from the private sphere
