

Versailles (or Trianon) Treaty (1920): 2/3 of the area, 65 % population, appr. 70% of natural resources (mines)


II. World War and its end (04.1945.): 1/4 of the area, appr. 1.000.000 people

'Who controls the youth, controls the system.'

One of the first youth law in Europe (1971)

Why? = "Let's have Jimi Hendrix, a bit –

BUT: NO Cohn-Bendit!!! (Big Brother)

Established institutions in the 70s (research, community houses, trained leaders, leadership trainings and orders to have support...)

- in the 80s: youth clubs

Youth (as such) is important! ... it is a policy, but not politics or vice versa.


- Acts on basic rights (freedom of expression: demonstration, strike, right of association)

1990-94: Transition, transformation wait for ... not ... Godot, but State

- Rule of Law Role of State
- Long seria of new laws (education, Rights of the Child, social work)
- Privatization (in six years 80% state-owned 80 % private)
- Approx. 1.6 million people had "changed" +
 1.2 million on waiting lists
- National Youth Council fights for 'youth property'
- Oppeness and readiness

1994-1998: Preparation for Adoptation


- Transformation of NYC 'Children and Youth Council of Interests
- Ministry of Education (Youth Dept. and PM Office: involvement party politics!)
- First attempt: Law on National Foundation of Children and Youth (youth 'property' or infrastructure?)
- European Youth Centre opens on dec. 1995
- Mobilitás (Mobility) Youth Service

1998-2002: Adopt. Support. Do.

- Ministry of Youth and Sport (120 civil servant, 2 Md HUF budget)
- Mobilitás Regional Youth Services: redefine youth work: social skills (community, learning society) and tools for youth work (money, councelling, networking, cooperating)
- Mobilitás becoming a Youth Institute (National Agency, European Service, Research, Centre of Drog Prevention)
- Plan for establishing a system for youth workers' training (2002)

2002-2006: Inclusion and Exclusion

- Losers' and 'Winners'
- Political fight ... not for the youth, but for the money of youth affairs...



2006-?: Untergang - Government

- No Ministry
- No Budget
- No Attention
- No for Youth Action Plan
- No Prime Minister
- 'KISZ' Government

Youth work – in a fragile situation

- 14 training, 486 students (training: 2 years vocational training)
- Mobilitas: Quality (ISO), Accreditation for specified trainings (Human Rights, Local Youth Work), new publication strategy
- New action plans for local and regional governments (eg.: Budapest)
