Description	<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>European Sport Charter</li></ul> <p>The European Sport Charter and the Code of Sport Ethics is a policy framework for sport which aims at promoting the physical and mental well-being of young athletes.</p> <p><i>Sports ethics – physical and psychological aspects</i> <i>Fair play means more than just abiding by the rules. It covers such notions as friendship, respect for others and the sporting spirit. Sports ethics signify not just a certain form of behaviour but also a particular way of thinking. It involves the elimination of cheating, bending the rules, doping, abuse of food additives, physical and verbal violence, the harassment and sexual abuse</i></p>
