






Dimension A: Inclusive practices for entry into school




Average score of Dimension A is **3.96** (VET school in Play 4.16 and VET school in Podgorica 3.76)


Familiarisation: differences among schools



Reasons for choosing this VET school




Dimension B: Inclusion within the school




Average score of Dimension B is **3.36** (VET school in Plav 3.67 and VET school in Podgorica 3.05)




Dimension C: Inclusive teaching and practice approaches

Promotion of social inclusion in schools







Conclusions

The institutional framework for vocational education in Montenegro offers a good basis for social inclusion at all stages of students' educational experience.

Differences among schools: inclusion is higher in primary schools

Differences among stakeholders: need for continuous research in order to catch the real picture of the situation

- •Development of the national system of selection of school directors
- •Higher involvement of local authorities and parents
- •Higher engagement of schools in order to familiarise students and their parents with the school prior to their enrolment
- •Improve communication between schools and former students (e.g. establishment of various associations of former students; alumni networks)
