



## TENDER FILE / TERMS OF REFERENCE

(Restricted consultation procedure / One-off contract)

The activities of the Council of Europe are governed by its [Statute](#) and its internal Regulations. Procurement is governed by the Financial Regulations of the Organisation and by [Rule 1333 of 29 June 2011 on the procurement procedures of the Council of Europe](#).

This tender procedure is a restricted consultation procedure. **In accordance with Rule 1333 of the Secretary General of the Council of Europe on the procurement procedures of the Council of Europe, the Organisation is in principle required to invite to tender at least three potential providers for any purchase between €2,000 (or €5,000 for intellectual services) and €55,000 tax exclusive.**

This tender procedure aims at concluding a one-off contract for the provision of services described in the Act of Engagement (See attached). Unless national legislation prescribes otherwise, deliverables executed on-site will be considered as performed in the country where the event takes place, and deliverables executed in writing will be considered as performed at the place where the Service Provider/Consultant is established. A tender is considered valid for 120 calendar days as from the closing date for submission. The selection of tenderers will be made in the light of the criteria indicated below. All tenderers will be informed in writing of the outcome of the procedure.

## E. ASSESSMENT

### *Exclusion criteria*

(by signing the Act of Engagement, you declare on your honour not being in any of the below situations)

Tenderers shall be excluded from participating in the tender procedure if they:

- have been sentenced by final judgment on one or more of the following charges: participation in a criminal organisation, corruption, fraud, money laundering;
- are in a situation of bankruptcy, liquidation, termination of activity, insolvency or arrangement with creditors or any like situation arising from a procedure of the same kind, or are subject to a procedure of the same kind;
- have received a judgment with res judicata force, finding an offence that affects their professional integrity or serious professional misconduct;
- do not comply with their obligations as regards payment of social security contributions, taxes and dues, according to the statutory provisions of their country of incorporation, establishment or residence.

### *Eligibility criteria*

- Proven working experience as an editor of a periodical publication, including of online publications
- Sound knowledge of the youth sector (youth policy, youth work, youth research, non-formal education etc.)
- Understanding of the specificities of online publications and experience on facilitating online exchanges
- Proficiency in English (C2 level /native speaker)
- Strong writing/editing/proofreading skills.

**The above mentioned points need to be presented in a succinct CV appended to the offer.**

Only bids submitted in English shall be deemed eligible.

### *Award criteria*

The selecting committee will assess the quality and price criteria of the offer, as follows:

- Quality of the offer (90%), including:
  - Quality and diversity of 3 proposed writing samples, appended or available on-line
  - Creativity and relevance of the ideas for the future scope, contents and format of Coyote magazine.

The above mentioned points need to be presented in a **motivation letter** appended to the offer. It should identify 3 strong sides of the Coyote magazine so far, and propose 3 innovations relevant for its future.

- Financial offer (10%):

The overall cost of the presented offer, which may not exceed 6.000 €, will also be considered in the selection.

Multiple tendering is not authorised.

## F. DOCUMENTS TO BE PROVIDED

Tenderers are invited to submit:

- 1) A completed and signed copy of the Act of Engagement<sup>1</sup> (See attached)**
  - 1.1. [For tenderers subject to VAT only] A quote (i.e. a Pro Forma invoice), on the letterhead of the tenderer, in line with the applicable legislation and listing:**
    - the Service Provider/Consultant's name and address;
    - the VAT number of the Service Provider/Consultant (if any);
    - the full list of deliverables;
    - the fee per deliverable (in Euros, tax exclusive);
    - the total amount (in Euros, tax exclusive) and;
    - specific payment modalities (if any, e.g. modalities of advance payment).
  - 2) A succinct CV reflecting the above-listed eligibility criteria, including contact details of 3 referees**
  - 3) Motivation letter, identifying 3 strong sides of the Coyote magazine so far, and proposing 3 innovations relevant for its future**
  - 4) 3 samples of writing, eventually with on-line links to the published work.**

Incomplete tenders will not be considered.

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<sup>1</sup> The Council of Europe reserves the right to ask tenderers, at a later stage, to supply an extract from the record of convictions or failing that an equivalent document issued by the competent judicial or administrative authority of the country of incorporation, indicating that the first three above listed exclusion criteria are met, and a certificate issued by the competent authority of the country of incorporation indicating that the fourth criterion is met.
