Call for Experts

Update of the Training Kit 12: Youth Transforming Conflict

Deadline for applications: 23:59 CET 29 August 2022

The EU-Council of Europe Youth Partnership is looking for 2 to 4 editors/authors to update the Training kit 12 titled <u>Youth Transforming Conflict</u>. Training kits (T-kits) are hands-on materials meant for supporting the training and education of practitioners involved in international youth work. Since 1998, the Youth Partnership has been continuously developing T-kits and in recent years has been updating the content of different T-kits to reflect the continuous development of the youth work field. T-kit #12 on youth and conflict transformation was originally published in 2012 as the twelfth book in the T-kit series.

The update of the T-kit involves the review of the first edition, identifying main needs and gaps, new developments and debates to be taken into consideration in a new edition. An expert group will be set up to guide the update of the T-kit and the work of the editors. Following this process, the editors will propose a structure for the new edition and draft the texts. This means that some or most parts of the T-kit will be entirely rewritten by the editors. Additional contributors might be also involved in drafting specific parts of the T-kit, depending on the needs.

The editors will:

- Participate in planning and editorial meetings about the update of the T-kit with the EU-Council of Europe Youth Partnership secretariat and take guidelines from the expert group set up to guide the update process into consideration when designing the new T-kit;
- Take part, contribute to and collect input from participants of the online and/or offline meetings of the expert group;
- Collect the needs and expectations of an updated T-kit from youth organisations, young people and youth sector stakeholders, through consultations and surveys;
- Prepare an outline and a structure of a new T-kit based on the results of the consultations, surveys and guidelines of the expert group;
- Write and peer review parts of the T-kit;
- Prepare guidelines for illustrations and visual elements of the T-kit, and cooperate with an illustrator on production of the visuals;

- Contribute to the dissemination of the T-kit, including promoting it at events, participating in a podcast recording, etc.

Expertise and profile of the editors:

- A good understanding and knowledge of the youth sector, with a special focus on peace and conflict and interrelated emerging challenges in society;
- Experience in developing and delivering educational activities, including, but not exclusively about peace, conflict and conflict resolution and human rights and/or experience in providing consultancy services related to peace and conflict;
- Significant experience with successfully local, regional and/or European projects in the field of youth, with special regard to topics such as peacebuilding, youth work in times of war, youth work in areas and communities in a post-conflict/frozen conflict situation;
- Experience in contributing to, or/and writing and editing educational publications preferably in the field of non-formal education, and coordinating the work of editorial teams are strong assets:
- Excellent writing and editing skills in English.

Tentative timeline

- September 2022: first planning meeting of the update
- October/November 2022: consultation meetings within the youth sector and surveys of potential users of the T-kit
- March 2023: submission of the first draft of the updated T-kit to the EU-Council of Europe Youth Partnership secretariat.
- March-April 2023: feedback process.
- April-June 2023: finalisation of the content of the T-kit, cooperation with an illustrator.
- 2nd half of 2023: finalisation of editorial work, dissemination activities.

First planning meeting: mid-September 2022 (tbc)

Expert meeting and meeting of editors: October/November 2022 (tbc)

Budget

The budget allocated to this project amounts about 9.000€. The fees offered to the editors will depend on their number and on the final allocation of tasks.
