The official currency is Moldovan Leu (MLD) and the exchange rate changes slightly (1 EUR is around 20 MLD).

There are ATM machines and a currency exchange office at the airport.

Transport and useful information

The airport is a 35-minute drive from Bristol Hotel.

The venue is in the very center of Chisinau and the airport express bus stops close by. You can get directly to the hotel from the Airport by taking trolleybus 30 and stopping at Mcdonalds Str. Pushkin (in front of the Town hall, next to Orange). The stop is only one block away from the hotel, walking downhill along the park.

Please note that you can pay by card or in euro for the bus ticket from/to the airport which costs 6 Lei (roughly 35 cents). As a rule, an additional 6 lei can be requested for luggage.

A taxi ride to the centre should cost max 150 MDL (roughly 7,5 EUR) and you should check with the driver if you can pay by card. We encourage you not to pursue taxi offers at the exit of the airport but to call the numbers suggested on the website.





Reimbursement
