Thus, the FJTs become not only support centers of young civil society, but also vectors of influence at the level of local authorities.



O1: Involvement of 20 county youth foundations in training activities throughout the project.



O2: During the project, the county youth foundation involved will develop and adopt efficient procedures in their work which will then be multiplied locally through support services for youth NGOs.



O3: At least half of the organizations involved will have alternative sources of funding, and at least 5 of the foundations will implement fundraising campaigns.

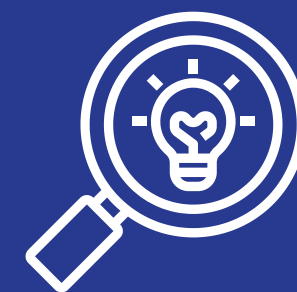

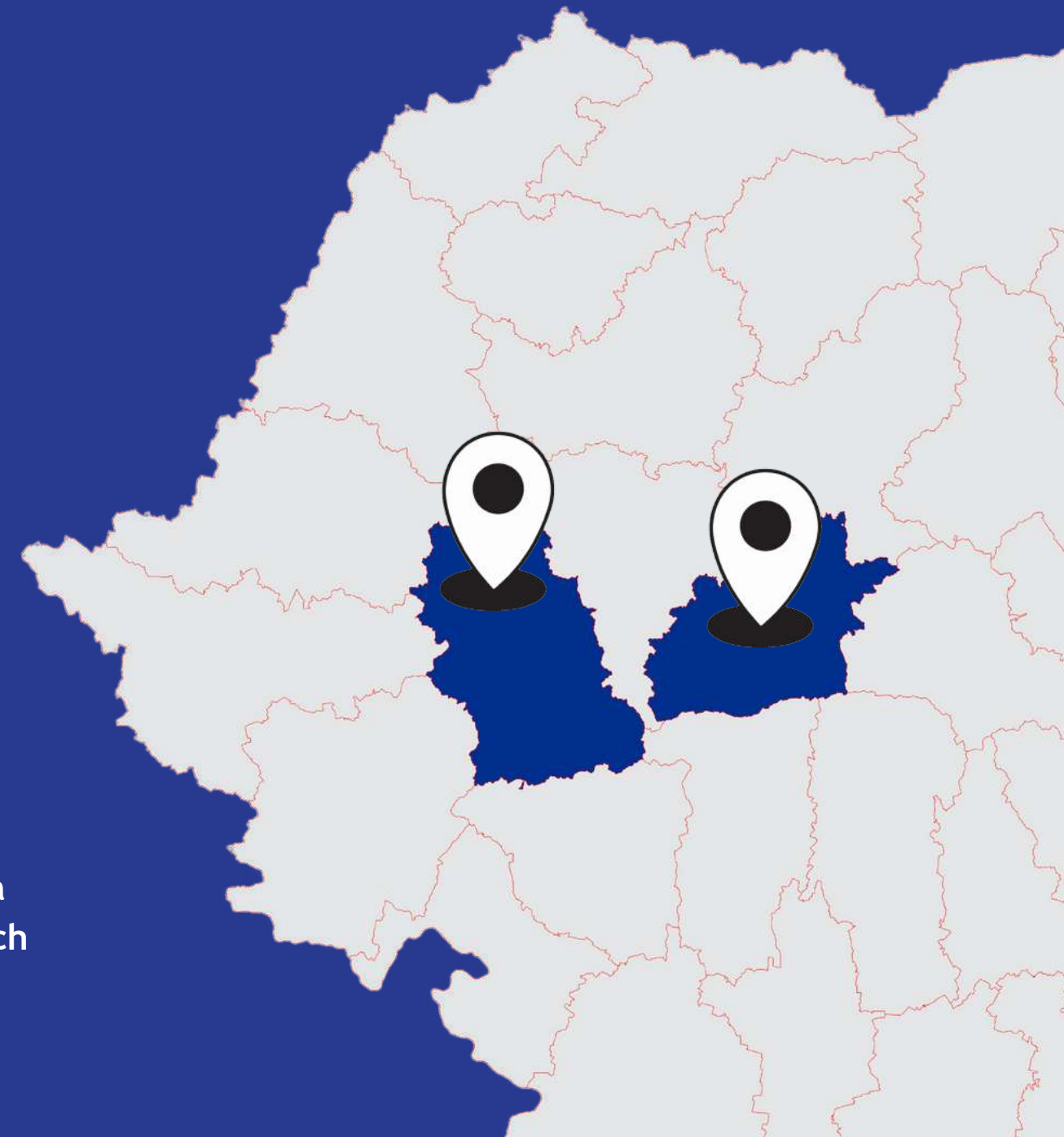

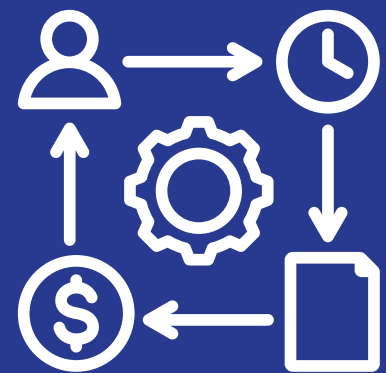

Empowering Youth for a Stronger European Democracy

The "Empowering Youth for a Stronger European Democracy" project aims to strengthen the democratic involvement of young Romanians, advancing their understanding of the democratic values of the European Union and the role of the European Parliament. With a focus on the 2024 European elections, the project intends to promote active citizen participation and deepen knowledge about the political landscape of the European Union.

ACTIVITIES

- Debates with young people, campaigns on social networks, quizzes, informative workshops and thematic events about the European Union in 10 youth centers in the country;
- Social media campaigns, consisting of 3 strategic digital initiatives;
- Interactive quizzes and workshops to enrich knowledge about the European Union and the European Parliament;
- Thematic events about the European Union;
- Establishing a Youth Ambassadors program.

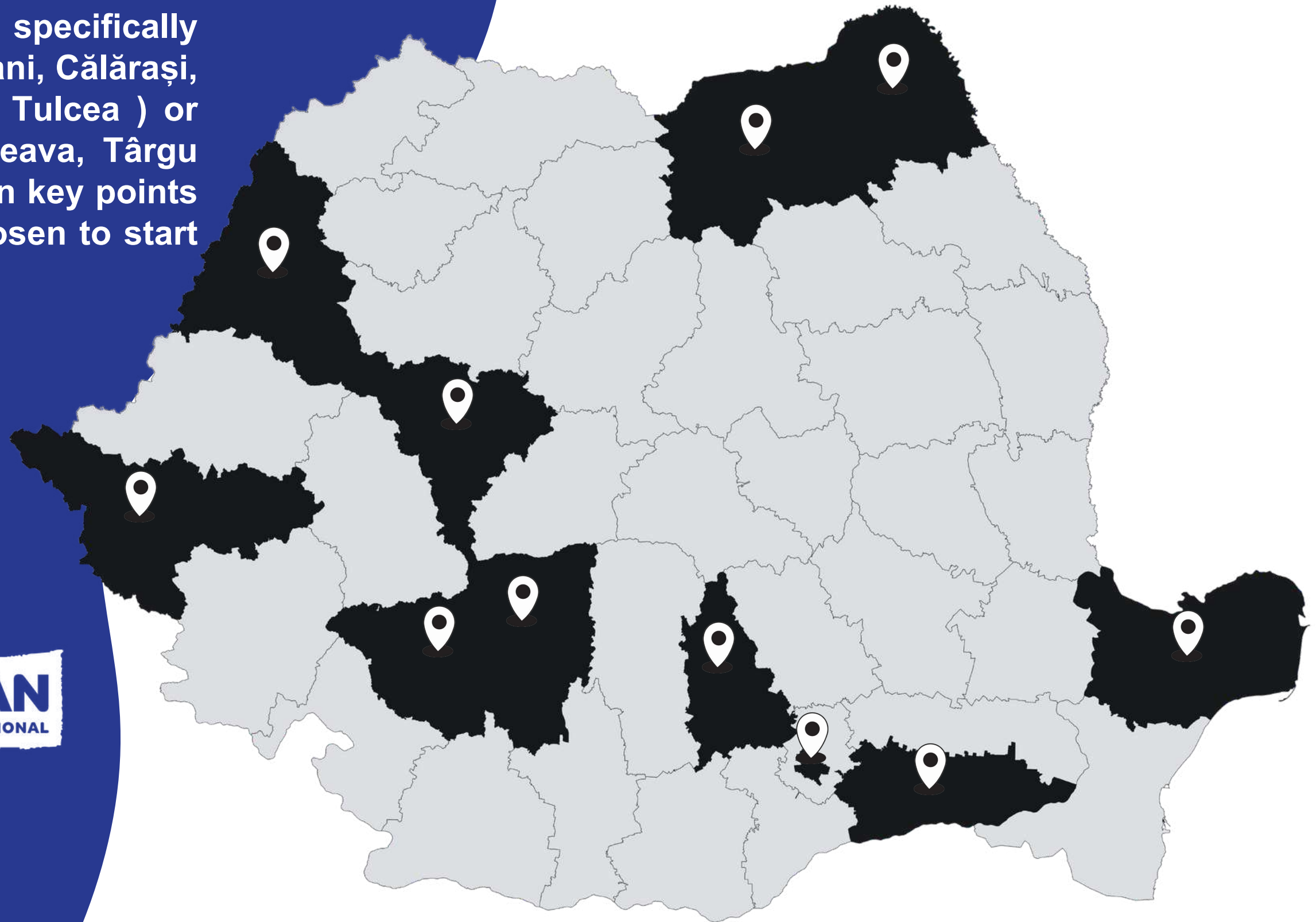

UKRAINIAN YOUTH INTERVENTION IN ROMANIA



Since end of March 2022, FNT started to implement the model of safe space (youth centre) for young Ukrainians who came from the conflict zone, based on the model already developed at the network level. The support from international non-governmental organizations (ActionAid International, Norwegian Refugee Council, Plan International) enhanced the interventions – by increasing number of staff specifically dedicated to such intervention (Alba Iulia, Botoșani, Călărași, Oradea, Râmnicu Vâlcea, Târgoviște, Timișoara, Tulcea) or by opening new youth centers (Bucharest, Suceava, Târgu Jiu). Now FNT is coordinating 11 youth centers in key points of the country, where young Ukrainians have chosen to start a new life.
