

Youth Work Developments in Serbia

- Standards for youth centers and youth clubs in national legislation through wide consultative process -Recognition of the youth work by other sectors (education, culture, social welfare, employment, etc.)

-Mobilisation of parents for increasing youth work recognition -Measuring youth work impact at personal and social level
