

1 Structures and actors that play a role in gaining a greater understanding and knowledge of young people

1.1 Departments in universities dealing with youth issues

There are no such Departments in Universities dealing just with youth issues. In general, Universities do not have departments dealing only with 1 topic. However, at the Institute of Philosophy and Sociology, University of Latvia (LU FSI www.fsi.lv) there is research grant on youth issues. Theme for 2002-2004 was #Youth Integration in transition# Theme for 2005-2007 #Risk of social exclusion of young people#. In 2004-2005 this LU FSI research group has received a grant from the Social Integration Foundation for a research #Identity development and participation of youth#. Researchers from LU FSI participate in the Nordic youth research network and Nordic doctoral studies network dealing with youth research. A few researchers at Daugavpils University do some research on regional youth (I.Ostrovska).

1.2 Major public and semi-public bodies dealing with youth issues

1.2.1 National public and semi-public bodies dealing with youth issues

Every public and governmental institution can apply and initiate a research on the topic important for the sphere the institution is dealing with. There is no unified system on youth research in Latvia. However Ministry of Children and Family affairs is responsible for implementation of youth policy in Latvia working out State Youth Policy Program provides consultations with other public and governmental institutions in order to include essential researches on youth on youth in the priorities of the State Program. In 2006 there is foreseen to start the research on voluntary activities and non-formal education activities in Latvia.

1.2.2 Local public and semi-public bodies dealing with youth issues

Every public or governmental institution can apply and initiate a research on the topic important for the sphere the institution is dealing with. There is no unified system on youth research on local level in Latvia. Generally it is a local municipality which is initiating and financing researches on local level.

1.3 NGOs dealing with youth issues

Latvian Youth Council in frames of projects and programs financed by European Programs provides researches on youth issues. In 2005 there is a research on development on youth non-formal education in Latvia initiated by the Latvian Youth Council and financed by Social Integration Foundation.

1.4 Statistic offices that collect statistics on youth



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There is no specific statistic office that collects statistics on youth. Latvian Central Statistic Bureau is collects all national data on various topics and by age group division, in some topics young people aged 15-25 (young people are defined in Latvia as persons aged 15-25) are marked out as a specific group. If information on specific topic is needed for governmental bodies, it is possible to order surveys on age group needed. Central Statistical Bureau regularly prepares materials on children and young people for UNICEF (MONET project)

There is no specific EU funding for carrying out activities at national level aimed at acquiring better knowledge and understanding specifically on youth. However, it is possible to carry out researches on youth in the frames of projects # for example, the Social Integration Foundation or Social Foundation, European Foundation for Regional Development.

3.3 National funding for carrying out activities aimed at acquiring a better knowledge and understanding of youth

3.3.1 Public national funding

There is no specific budget line for public national funding for youth research. NGOs, research institutes, private companies may apply and initiate a research on a topic important for the sphere if the institution is dealing with applying for funding in the governmental institution dealing with issues connected with the topic of the research. However the Ministry for Children and Family affairs responsible for implementation of youth policy in Latvia working out State Youth Policy Program organises consultations with other sectoral institutions in order to include essential researches on youth in the priorities of the State Youth Policy Program, activities of which are financed by the state.
