The specific youth departments in Universities are Instituto de Ciências Sociais da Universidade de Lisboa (ICS/UL) Instituto Superior de Ciências do Trabalho e da Empresa (ISCTE) Centro de Investigação e Estudos de Sociologia (CIES/ISCTE) Instituto de Estudos Políticos da Universidade Católica Portuguesa (IEP/UCP).

#### 1.2 Statistic offices that collect statistics on youth

The office in charge for statistics information is Instituto Nacional de Estatística. In Portugal, there's no knowledge of any organisation devoted solely to youth statistics information. There's, however Observatório Permanente da Juventude, which is in charge of producing several studies about youth condition and that also gathers information and statistical studies on this area. Among others, the most recent "Análise Longitudinal das Fontes Estatísticas 1990-2005 (Analysis of Statistics Sources 1990-2005)", published under José Machado Pais and Manuel Villaverde Cabral scientific coordination.

### 1.3 Major public and semi-public bodies dealing with youth issues (included public companies) (give name and mandate and themes of research this year)

The National public body dealing specifically with youth issues is Instituto Português da Juventude. The semi-public bodies in this area are Fundação para a Divulgação das Tecnologias de Informação (private and public funds), Movijovem (private and public funds) and Conselho Consultivo da Juventude (composed by young people from national youth organisations and public managers)

Most published works about youth issues are integrated in the sphere of action of **Observatório Permanente da Juventude** (Youth Observatory): among them stand out the several works inserted in the collection "Estudos sobre Juventude" (Youth Studies), in areas such as art, risk behaviour, minority integration, university, among others. The most recent publication resulting from this partnership is *"A Condição Juvenil Portuguesa na Viragem do Milénio"* (The Youth Portuguese Profil in the Millennium Turn) coordinated by Víctor Sérgio Ferreira, based on the "Estudo Estatístico sobre a População Juvenil Portuguesa (1999-2005)" - Statistic study about youth Portuguese population (1999-2005).

There are other works published by IPJ outside this partnership, the latter being "O Associativismo Juvenil e a Cidadania Política" (Youth Associativisme and Political Citizenship).

There's no data available about works published outside these contexts.

There are no regular Youth Reports. Nevertheless, there is a very recent publication based on 1999 – 2005 youth inquires such as The Youth Portuguese Profil in the Turn of the Millenium /A Condição Juvenil Portuguesa na Viragem do Milénio; There was also a 2005 study made by Marktest (a private company working in the statistics area) called "Fone Bus" gathering

various information about youth (statistics on political participation, dissemination of governmental programs, public institutions working in the Youth field, etc.)
