

Draft Law for Development of Youth

Article 84 (1) The money of "Development of Youth in Bulgaria" Fund shall be spent in compliance with the National Strategy for Youth and the National Plan for Youth for: item 10. researches of youth and studies for ensuring planning, observation and assessment of policies for development of youth – not less than 2%, but not more than 5% of the annual budget of the fund;

Article 108(1) The State Agency for Youth and Sports shall organise and support: 1. research of needs and development of young people in Bulgaria;

General Directorate "Policy for Youth" issues on annual basis about 2000 copies of BG Youth Newsletter on paper. The newsletter provides information about the opportunities supported by the State Agency for Youth and Sports in relation to young people to make them able to implement their youth ideas. Different initiatives, good practices and materials provided by the young people for the young people may be found in the newsletter. In 2007 General Directorate "Policy for Youth" issued 2000 copies of 2008 Youth Compass travel guide containing current information useful to the young people countrywide. The largest national youth meeting that is organised in Bulgaria on annual basis is the National Forum "BG YOUTH". The forum is a partnership meeting among representatives of non-governmental sector and the institutions involved in the field of youth activities and young people's problems. Each year, representatives of more than 150 NGOs take part in the Forum. The main purpose of this large youth event during the year is to provide opportunity for direct dialogue between the state authorities and the civil sector for the implementation of effective youth policy at national, regional and local level

9.1 Seminars and working groups for a better knowledge and understanding of youth

During the year the General Directorate "Policy for Youth" organises many trainings and educational seminars during which issues related to the better knowledge and understanding of youth are discussed, as well as issues related to the implementation of youth ideas through the youth activities programs. The seminars and trainings are attended both by employees of the State Agency for Youth and Sport and by representatives of youth NGOs.

A constant national internet youth network is the network <u>www.mikc.bg</u>.

Its is established on the basis of National Program "Youth Information and Consultancy Centres" and at present 32 websites are connected among each other and exchange youth information for searching of partnerships, work on projects, organising of seminars, conferences, public debates, etc. in the field of youth policy and actions.
