3.1 International funding for carrying out activities aimed at youth research



The Department of Youth Affairs under the Ministry of Social Security and Labour calls for applications once a year. Funding is made upon successful applications. Total amount in 2008 was 695 088 euros.



Each Lithuanian municipality has a fund for funding Youth activities. Usually funding is made upon successful applications.

The Department of Youth Affairs under the Ministry of Social Security and Labour in 2008 has published: methodical publication "Open Youth Centres"; translated to Lithuanian and published series of youth training handbooks T-kit which were prepared by European Council and European Commission.

The Department of Youth Affairs under the Ministry of Social Security and Labour publishes reports on Youth policy in Lithuania. Such reports are not considered as regular.

4.3 Journals and reviews on youth research

The Department of Youth Affairs under the Ministry of Social Security and Labour announces results of Youth situation researches periodically. Results are divided according to different regulated fields of youth policy. Department of Statistics under the Government of the Republic of Lithuania (Statistics Lithuania) annually publishes yearbook of Lithuanian statistics, which also contents data on youth situation.

The Department of Youth Affairs under the Ministry of Social Security and Labour starts running the working group, that concentrates on the questions of youth information and researches, in which one of the target groups would be young people. This working group consists of the delegates of the state institutions. Also there would be another working, which will deal with such questions, but the members of this group will be the delegates from Universities. There is planned, that these two groups are going to outgrow into the network of experts, who will deal with information related to youth.

Lithuanian Youth Council (LiJOT), <u>www.lijot.lt</u>. LiJOT is the biggest non-governmental, non-profit umbrella structure for Lithuanian national youth organizations and regional unions of youth organizations. LiJOT is the organisation, that represents youth interests for Lithuanian governmental institutions, promotes youth initiative, youth mutual understanding and etc.

National association of Youth Coordinators (NJRK), <u>www.njrk.lt</u>. This is the association that unites municipal co-ordinators for youth matters. They are responsible for local youth policy formation and implementation in Lithuanian municipality.

Council of Youth Affairs formed on the principle of parity: 6 representatives from government institutions (ministries and Government Office) and 6 representatives from youth organisations (delegated by National Youth Council). The Council composition is approved by Prime Minister. The Council is advisory body for the Director of the Department of Youth Affairs under the Ministry of Social Security and Labour.
