Title

Providing information and guidance

Scope, aim and objectives

Youth information and guidance consist in a wide range of activities, projects, schemes and frameworks which aim at providing young people with necessary information, counselling and support for them to be able to undergo a smooth though pro-active transition from childhood to adulthood and from school to work in areas such as education, employment, autonomy, professional and personal development.

Youth information and guidance are therefore *sine qua non* mechanisms to ensure tailor-made and targeted initiatives in supporting young people to make grounded and informed decisions about which learning mobility programmes or projects take part in.

The aim of this workshop is to share a good understanding of what consist information and guidance of and to explore existing mechanisms and practices with regard to learning mobility for young people.

The objectives are:

- To look at the main actors involved in information, counselling and guidance for young people with a focus on learning mobility opportunities;
- To examine the type of information and services provided by information and guidance structures;
- To explore the link of youth information, counselling and guidance with key areas such as citizenship, cross-cultural understanding, inclusion, competence development and quality;
- To look at best practices in the field of youth information, counselling and guidance, including related training schemes such as 'the Jimmy concept'.
