## The activity

The *MOSAIC* Training Seminar on Religion is the second such training seminar for trainers working in a Euro-Mediterranean youth context.

The first training seminar took place in December 2008 in Antalya, Turkey, and focused on the theme of 'Gender Equality in Training for Euro-Mediterranean Youth Work'. It allowed participants who were active trainers within Euro-Mediterranean youth work to be introduced to Mosaic, the T-Kit on Euro-Mediterranean youth work and explore the issues of the seminar further, whilst developing strategies for future cooperation and networking within the Euro-Mediterranean youth context. At the end of the seminar, the participants reinstated the importance of such activities in further developing their competences on particular themes of their work and suggested the next Mosaic training seminar to focus on Religion.

The seminar this year will follow similar objectives as the previous one, with the thematic focus being Religion, a topic of obvious concern for all actors in Euro-Mediterranean youth work but also as a theme where trainers can effectively share approaches, methodologies and challenges.

The training seminar will bring together participants who were previously involved in the Euro-Mediterranean youth work with the Youth Partnership/Council of Europe and the Salto Euromed Resource Centre, including former TATEM and TOTEM participants.

## Objectives

The seminar aims at providing an opportunity for trainers active in Euro-Mediterranean youth projects to further develop their competences in working with religion in their activities.

Specific objectives of the seminar include:

- to become familiar with the T-Kit on Euro-Mediterranean Youth Work (MOSAIC) and explore its contents and activities, particularly in relation to religion;
- to deepen participants' competence in addressing religion in the Euro-Mediterranean youth context;
- to share information about the developments in the Euro-Mediterranean youth field;
- to support informal networking between trainers active in Euro-Mediterranean youth activities;
- to contribute to the future developments, strategies and programmes in relation to training of trainers in the Euro-Mediterranean area by the Partnership and Salto.

The trainers invited to take part in the course by the Partnership and the Salto EuroMed RC must confirm their interest by filling in the appended form for expression of interest. The deadline for confirmation is <u>23 September 2009</u>.

## Financial and practical conditions of participation

#### Travel expenses

Travel expenses and visa fees are reimbursed (on presentation of the relevant receipts) according to the rules of the Council of Europe. The travel expenses will only be reimbursed upon presentation of documentary evidence of the sum actually paid. For this reason, the original INVOICE is necessary (issued by the travel agency or other ticket issuing company). Electronic tickets will only be considered as acceptable on proof of payment (invoice) and on presentation of the boarding pass for the outward journey). This evidence of the expenditure will be joined to the claim form for reimbursement together with the relevant travel tickets or a copy (plane, train, etc). Please buy return tickets for your full journey. Only the participants who attend the entire training seminar can be reimbursed. The payment will be made by bank transfer after the course.

We advise you to seek the <u>direct flights</u> to Antalya though travel agencies.

#### Accommodation

Accommodation and meals will be provided in Antalya, Turkey and paid for by the Turkish National Agency.

#### Dates

The training seminar will begin on <u>Wednesday, 4 November 2009 and finish on Saturday, 7</u> <u>November 2009</u>.

Arrival and departure should be planned for 3rd and 8th November 2009, accordingly.
