

European Students' Forum

- Opinion of AEGEE members no experts
- Participatory tools to include as many people as possible in the process
- Ratification at the bi-anual general assembly

UNIVERSITIES



- Improve the dialogue between the management of the university and youth organizations present there – Involve them in the decisions taken
- Provide infrastructures
- Help to improve the flow of information
- Tuition waivers ECTS credits





- Local governments
 - Database of organizations present in the city
 - Infrastructure
 - Person responsible of coordinating and promoting the activities of NGYOs
 - Promotion of best practices to increase the recognition of volunteering

POLICY MAKERS



- National and European governments
 - Recognise the figure of the volunteer by valorising the experiences and giving it an official status
 - Facilitate the visa procedures for non-EU volunteers
 - Stable support to national youth councils
 - Promotion of a voluntary social year
 - Simplify the administrative tasks of NGYOs
 - Implement a tutoring system to support NGYOs
