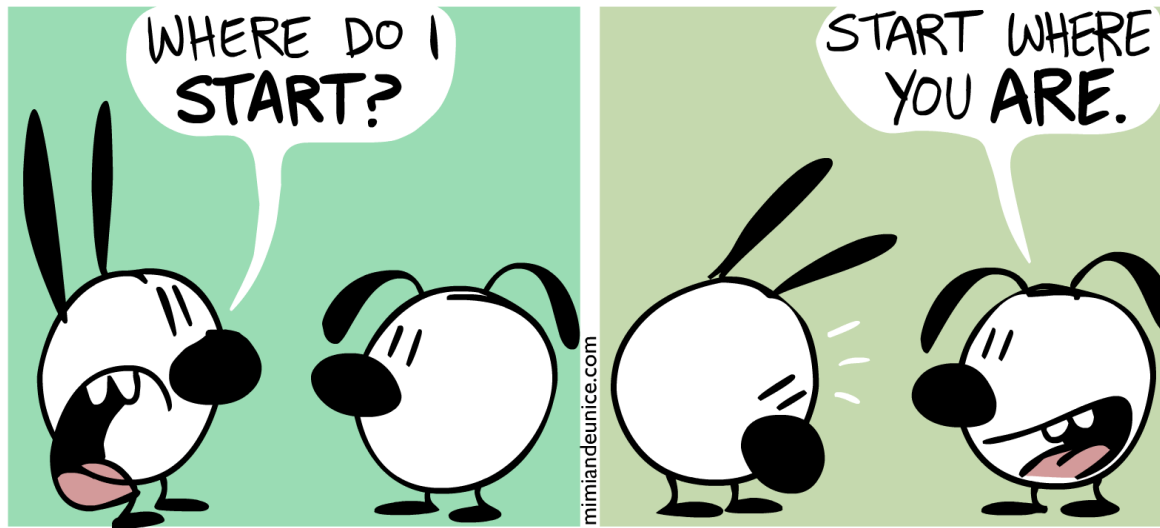

❑ Where does participation start?

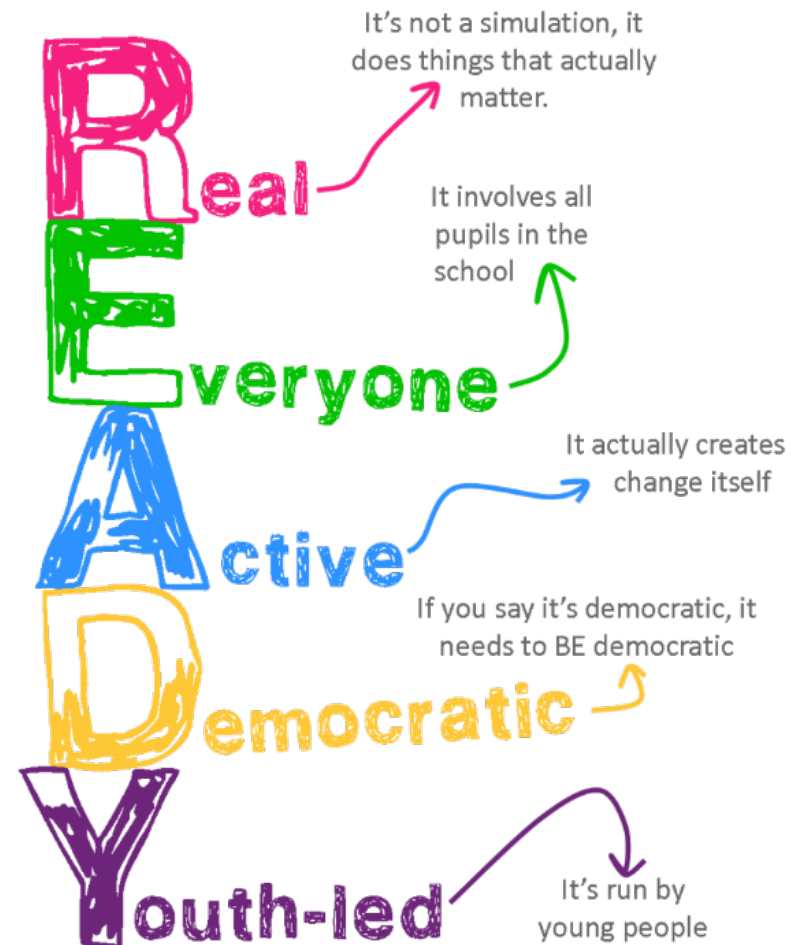

- ❑ OBESSU is a platform for cooperation between the national school student Unions active in general secondary and secondary vocational education in Europe.
- ❑ Founded: 1975., Dublin, Ireland
- ❑ Based in: Brussels, Belgium
- ❑ OBESSU gathers 24 member organisations from 19 European countries
- ❑ All organisations are independent, national, representative and democratic School Student Unions

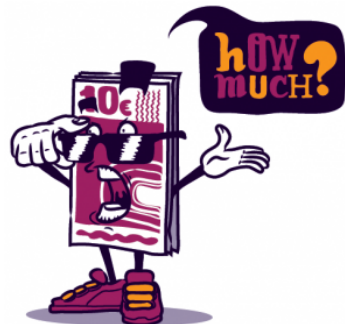
