## YOUTH WORKER PROGRAMME

### NOWADAYS IS:

- » An integral part of the Roadmap for reform of youth policies in Ukraine of the “Reanimation Package of Reforms”.
- » One of priorities of the National Targeted Programme “Youth of Ukraine 2016-2020”.
- » A tool for mainstreaming European approaches and standards of youth work in Ukraine.
- » A driver for official recognition of the terms “youth work” and “youth worker”.



### PROGRAMME DESIGN:

Trainings for female and male professionals from public and non-governmental sectors (50/50) who work with youth.

- » Graduates of the trainings will receive state certificate.





## WHY?

### PROGRAMME GOAL:

- » Improve knowledge and competence of youth leaders and youth sector professionals for the efficient development and implementation of evidence-based local and regional youth policies.
- » Create a database of youth sector professionals and best practices of local and regional youth policies.
- » To foster effective dialogue between public authorities and civil society organizations for youth development in Ukraine.
- » Inform institutions working with youth on the best national and international practices of the development and implementation of youth policies through the research, training, consultations, and youth development-driven projects and programmes.





## WHO?

### TARGET AUDIENCE OF THE PROGRAMME:

- » Leaders and activists of civil society organisations and charities working with youth.
- » Public servants responsible for local and regional youth policies.
- » Professionals of other organizations (public, community, civil society, private, etc.) engaged into work with youth.

The Programme includes  
three types of trainings –  
***basic, special and trainings  
for trainers.***





## HOW TO GET ENROLLED?

No special education background, reference letters from the management or membership to certain organizations is necessary to get enrolled to the Programme. The only requirement is having experience and motivation to work with youth. Participation in the Programme is free of charge for both the participant and his/her organization.
