- Following elected politicians and checking whether their work matches their promises.











#### European Parliament

European Parliament (EP) - legislative branch of the European Union, whose members are directly elected from EU member states every 5 years since 1979.

Each EU member state has a set number of seats in EP, however, after elections members of the European Parliament work in groups based on political views and not on nationalities.











### The powers of European Parliament:

- 1. **Passing laws** (together with the Council of the EU, based on European Commission proposals);
- 2. Deciding on international agreements;
- 3. Establishing the EU budget;
- 4. Electing the Commission President and approving the Commission as a body...




