# Perspective on Youth Work Developments BOSNIA AND HERZEGOVINA FACT SHEET

The 3<sup>rd</sup> European Youth Work Convention (EYWC) plays a key role in launching the implementation of the European Youth Work Agenda (EYWA) as a strategic framework for further developing and strengthening youth work practice and policies in Europe. The goal of this fact sheet is to provide basic information about the perspective on youth work developments in a specific country. Youth organization from Bosnia and Herzegovina - PRONI Center for youth development has trained more than 100 youth workers using combined online and traditional non-formal education and opened five more youth clubs in five different cities that never had youth clubs before.

- Joining the Erasmus + and European Solidarity Corps funding mechanisms
- More contact making seminars and networking opportunities for local youth organisations which often have difficulties finding international partners.

- Supporting further development of quality youth work;
