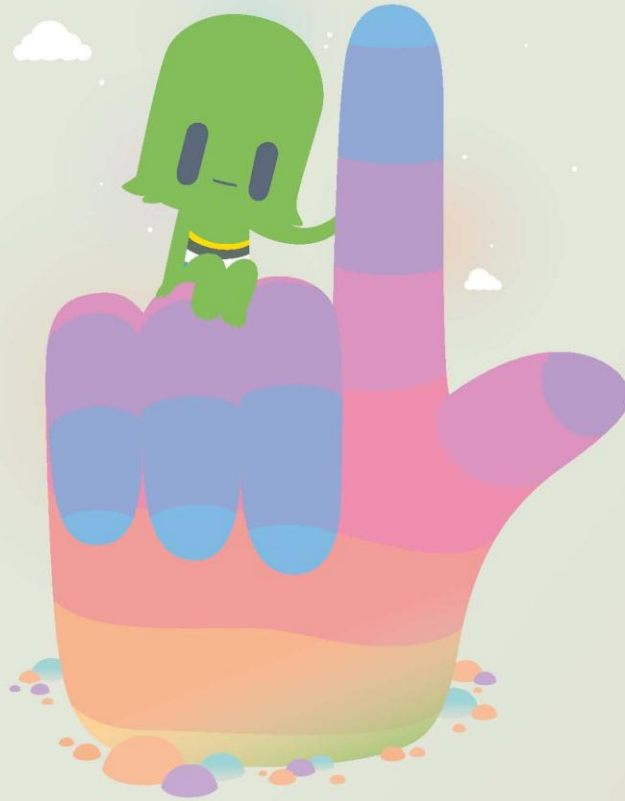

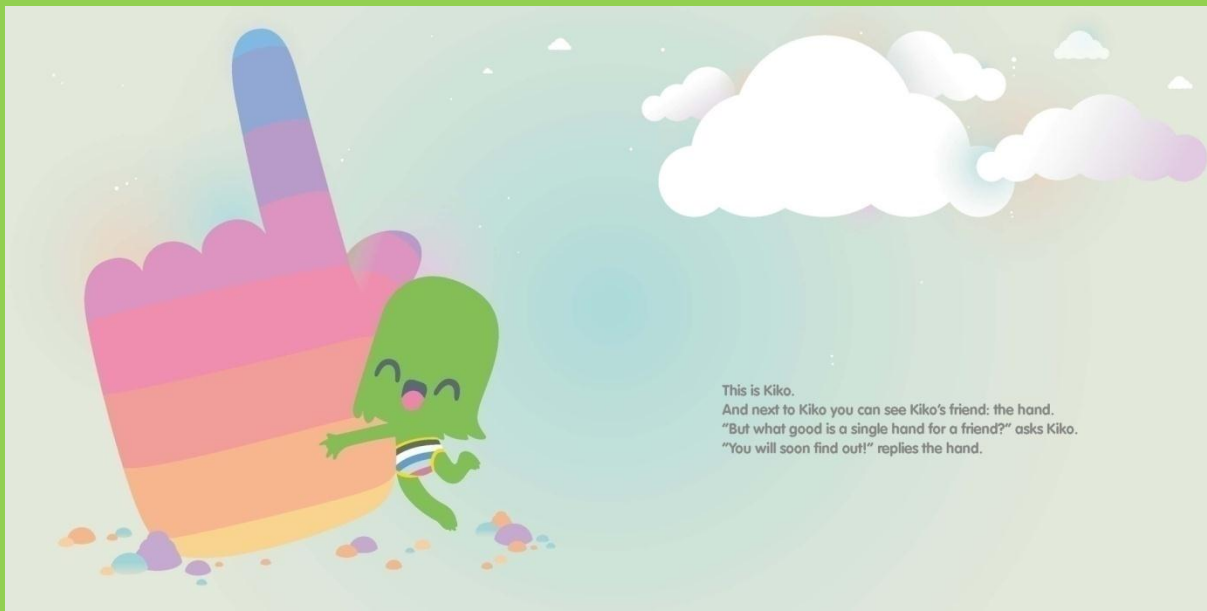

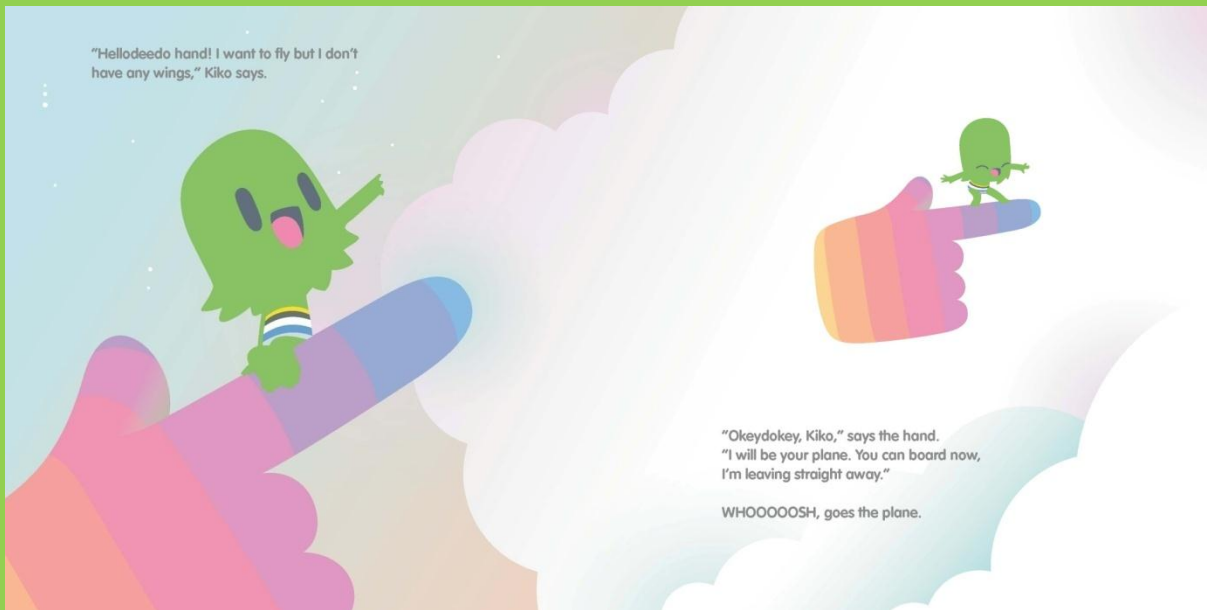

"You will soon find out!" replies the hand.



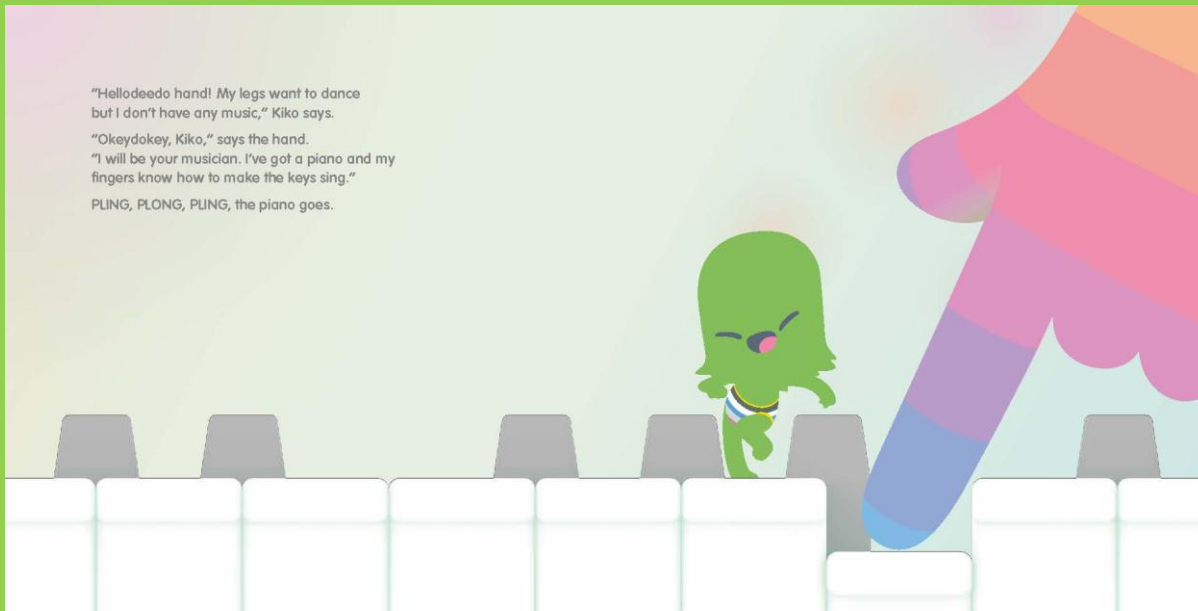

BOOK KIKO AND THE HAND

A child should not be touched by others on parts of the body usually covered by their underwear



Nor children should touch others in those areas

- Their body belongs to them
- There are good and bad secrets
- There is good but also bad touch

FIVE IMPORTANT ASPECTS OF THE RULE

1. Your body is your own

No-one is allowed to touch their body without their permission

CHILDREN

- have the right to refuse a kiss or a touch
- should be taught to say "NO", immediately and firmly, to inappropriate physical contact
- should be taught to get away from unsafe situations
- should be taught to tell a trusted adult



FIVE IMPORTANT ASPECTS OF THE RULE

2. Good touch - bad touch

PARENTS

- Tell your children it is not okay if someone looks at or touches their private parts of their body, or asks them to look at or touch someone else's private parts



An obvious easy-to-remember border: THE UNDERWEAR

FIVE IMPORTANT ASPECTS OF THE RULE

3. Good secrets - bad secrets

Secrecy is a main tactic of sexual abusers

PARENTS

- It's important to teach the difference between good and bad secrets
- Every secret that makes them anxious, uncomfortable, fearful or sad is not good and should not be kept
- On the contrary it should be told to a trustworthy adult



THE UNDERWEAR RULE

FIVE IMPORTANT ASPECTS OF THE RULE

4. Prevention and protection are the responsibility of an adult

Abused children feel shame, guilt and fear

ADULTS

- Should make sure their children know whom to turn to if they are worried, anxious or sad
- Should be attentive and receptive to their children's feelings and behavior

CHILDREN

- Should always feel that they can talk to their parents about this issue



FIVE IMPORTANT ASPECTS OF THE RULE

5. Information, reporting, disclosure

Children need to be instructed about adults who can be part of their safety network.

- Only one member of the safety network should live with the child
- The other should live outside the immediate family circle

Children should know how to seek help from such a trust network



FIVE IMPORTANT ASPECTS OF THE RULE

Known perpetrators

In most cases the perpetrator is someone known to the child. It is difficult for the children to understand that someone who knows them could abuse them.

RULE

A set rule must be in the house; informing parents regularly about someone who:

- gives him/her GIFTS
- asks him/her to keep SECRETS
- tries to spend time ALONE with the child



FIVE IMPORTANT ASPECTS OF THE RULE

Unknown perpetrators

In some cases the perpetrator is a stranger.

PARENTS

Teach your child simple rules about contact with strangers:

- never get into a car with a stranger
- never accept gifts or invitations from a stranger



THE UNDERWEAR RULE

FIVE IMPORTANT ASPECTS OF THE RULE

HELP

Children should know that there are:



- Professionals that can be particularly helpful
- Special welfare centers where they can seek help
- Helplines they can call to seek advice and help

WHY THE UNDERWEAR RULE?

Child abuse happens to children of every gender, every age, every skin colour, every social class and every religion

The perpetrator is often someone the child knows and trusts

The perpetrator can also be a child

YOU CAN HELP PREVENT THIS HAPPENING TO YOUR CHILD
Good communication is the key



WHAT TO DO IF YOU SUSPECT CHILD SEXUAL ABUSE



- x Do not get angry with the child
- x Do not make your child feel as they have done something wrong
- x Try not to be upset in front of your child
- x Try not to jump to conclusions
- ✓ Reassure your child that you will do something about it
- ✓ Contact someone who could help, like a psychologist, child care specialist, doctor, social worker or the police

THE UNDERWEAR RULE

7 helplines

1056 National Helpline for Children SOS (The Smile of the Child)

- Free, 24 hrs/day.
- The main goal of the helpline is to protect and defend the rights of children.
- It accepts reports on children - victims of abuse.
- It interferes on site if they are in danger.
- Psychological support for children and adolescents and consulting for parents and educators is provided.
- Information and orientation on issues pertaining to children's rights and protection.
- Phone conversations are privileged and are NOT recorded.

1107 National Helpline for Child Protection

- Free, 24hrs/day
- Information available directly and consulting provided in emergencies, as well as psychological and social support on issues troubling children and adolescents or if they are in danger.
- Link to the competent services, mobilization of emergency intervention mechanisms. Parents receive information and consulting on issues regarding their children and their own parenting role.
- It is part of the National Centre for Social Solidarity of the Ministry for Employment, Social Security and Welfare.
- It was established in March 2012 and handles calls on any form of violence against children and adolescents.
- The 197 Immediate Social Help Hotline belongs to the network of services provided by the National Centre for Social Solidarity.

116-111 European Helpline for Children and Adolescents

- Free, Monday through Friday: 14:00 - 20:30, Saturday: 9:30 - 14:00
- A helpline providing advice exclusively to children and adolescents on any subject troubling them.
- This number applies to all European countries!
- Phone conversations are privileged.
- Counsellors act only in case of emergency and upon consultation with the child calling.

80011 80015 "SUPPORT" Helpline

- Free, Monday through Friday: 9:00 a.m. - 3:00 p.m.
- The Unit for Adolescent Health of the B' Paediatrics Clinic of the University of Athens, operates the SUPPORT Helpline 80011 80015 of the Greek Awareness Centre Safer Internet, under the umbrella of the European Commission. It concerns minors and their families.
- It provides support and counselling on issues relating to the use of the internet, mobile phones, and electronic games (harassment, addiction, harmful material, paedophilia etc.)

115 25 Helpline "Together for Children" of the "Together for Children" Association

- Local call charge, Monday through Friday: 9:00 a.m. - 9:00 p.m.
- Counseling for children, adolescents, parents and teachers.
- Free counselling supporting the mental health of children, regarding domestic violence issues and children with special needs.

- Free, Monday through Friday: 9:00 a.m. - 4:00 p.m.
- A helpline of the Ombudsman accepting calls by children and adolescents up to 18 years of age.

11012 Subdivision of the Cyber Crime Unit (Ministry of Public Order and Citizen Protection)

- Citizens may turn to the cyber crime unit to report criminal acts perpetrated online and for issues regarding the protection of minors, such as child pornography and seduction of minors via the internet etc.
- Citizens are also referred to the 2106476464 helpline.

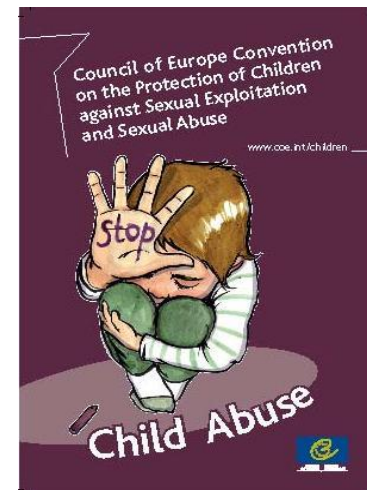

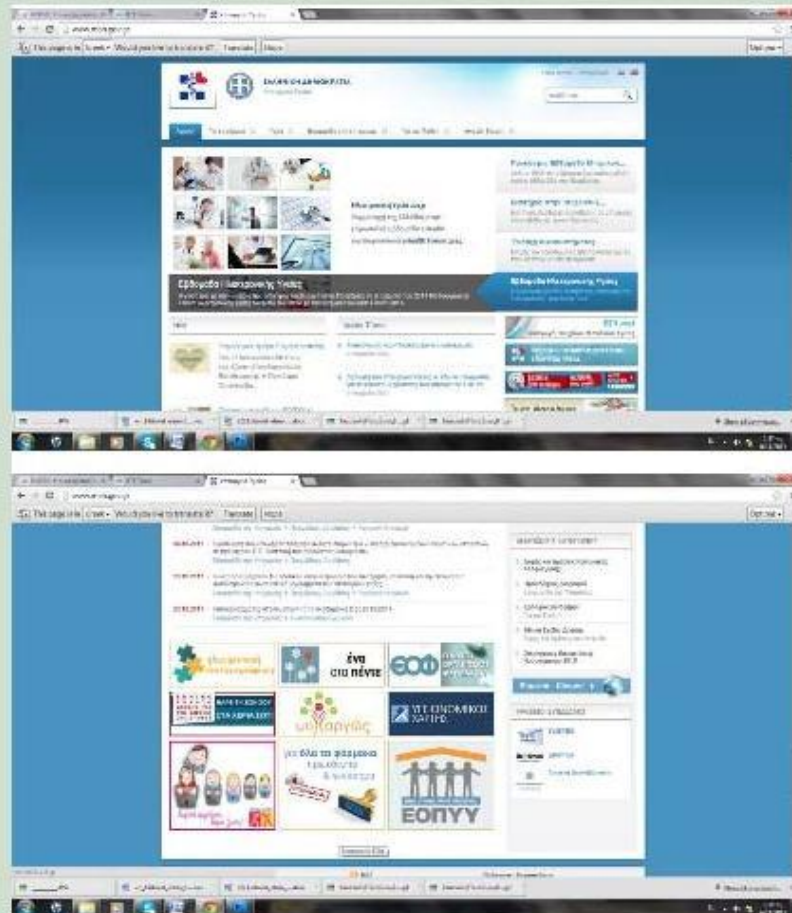

“Stricter criminal penalties for pedophiles”

I noted that the issue of child sexual abuse is in the top of the Council of Europe priorities, being an enormous problem with the utmost serious social repercussions and I asked the Minister if he can proceed with reviewing the relevant criminal provisions, so that all crimes against sexual freedom of minors under the age of 15 will be considered hideous and be exemplary punished and if, in these new law reform, pedophiles will be exempted from the general leniency provisions related to sentences suspensions and to conditional prisoners release

The current process is slow and the accompanying social and psychological consequences are serious. It is necessary to create an effective system for the protection of children victims of sexual abuse.

What could possibly be named “Houses for Children, victims of sexual abuse” has a very advanced system in Sweden and the second in The Netherlands. The Ministry of Health should give a statement and a plan of action.

In the framework of the extraordinary meeting of the Parliamentary Network, Ms Elena Rapti has distributed to the Network members an electronic format (CD) of the report on the up-to-date actions and initiatives of the "ONE in FIVE" campaign in Greece, with the aim of exchanging views and good practices for the elimination of child sexual abuse.



The Hellenic Model



As a member of the Hellenic Parliament, a member of the Parliamentary Assembly of the Council of Europe (PACE) and the Network of Contact Parliamentarians to stop sexual violence against children I am coordinating the "ONE in FIVE" campaign in Greece.

With this mandate I undertook immediately a series of actions on a national scale in order to inform and to raise awareness on the issue among the Greek citizens. I have held meetings through which I have forged the necessary relations and alliances so as to increase the number of supporters for this cause and to spread the message of the campaign to a wider extent. Furthermore, I have submitted to the PACE a series of proposals on how to promote the

campaign in my country in order to achieve a mass mobilization on the issue at national level. Through my presence in every action undertaken and the participation of various public stakeholders we have managed to create the proper dynamic that will help attain this objective.

Since February 2013 I have met, consecutively, with institutional and state bodies. With the Prime Minister of the Hellenic Republic, with the Speaker of the Hellenic Parliament, asking him to support the campaign, with the Archbishop of Athens and All Greece - primate of the Orthodox Church of Greece, in order to inform citizens through the Church, with the Minister of Education and Religious Affairs, to promote the message to the educational community, with the Minister of Health for strengthening state welfare structures for children victims of violence, with the regional and local Governors in order to spread the message to their local communities, with the Head of the Hellenic Police, to join forces with us in tackling this phenomenon, with the Deputy Ombudsman for the Rights of the Child, with the Directors of various public and private TV channels, which have broadcast the "Kiko and the hand" TV spot for free, with the chairpersons of various state child care institutions, volunteer groups, special scientists and members of the academia, who have expressed their support for this national effort.

Furthermore, as of April 2013, I have carried out more than sixty (60) events to inform and raise awareness among the citizens. I chose to launch this campaign from the Greek Regions, in cooperation with the Cyber Crime Unit of the Hellenic Police and the Hellenic Amateur Athletic Association-SEBAS by organizing sporting events, informative events addressed to the public and volunteer groups. I have so far visited sixteen (16) cities around Greece and I will continue to do so, both in Periphery and the Capital also, so that we achieve widespread awareness.

At the same time, from the April 24th 2013 for a whole month and from the September 16th for a second month, the "Kiko and the hand" TV spot has been widely broadcasted for free, as a social message, with the approval of the Greek National Council for Radio & Television, by the 14 major public and private TV channels.

From the onset of the campaign in my country more than 70,000 copies of the CoE's relevant printed material have been handed out: the "Kiko and the Hand" children's book, the "Underwear rule" material, with guidelines for parents and the "7 helplines" leaflet. During my 31 appearances in numerous popular TV shows, I had the opportunity to present the campaign to the Greek viewers in order to raise awareness.

In my capacity as an MP, I have submitted six (6) parliamentary questions, urging a review of the child protection framework, at legislative and administrative level. In particular, I called for a stricter legal framework, to increase the protection framework of the victims and to train the educational community. I am quite satisfied by the fact that the Ministry of Health in cooperation with the NGO "The Smile of the Child" will shortly create in Athens the "Day Center for children and adolescents who have been the victims of abuse / neglect / domestic violence".

During the works of the 4th part of the 2013 Ordinary Session of the Council of Europe, at the meeting of the Network of Contact parliamentarians to stop sexual violence against children, I presented an updated report of actions of the "ONE in FIVE" campaign in Greece.

On the sidelines of the Session I gave an interview at the Press Point (Media Box) of the Council of Europe on the "ONE in FIVE" campaign in Greece and I presented the basic action plan of the Hellenic model.

In October, I represented the Council of Europe at the Conference on "Inclusion and Protection of Children in and through Sport", co-organized by EPAS (Enlarged Partial Agreement on Sport) and the Hungarian Secretariat of Sport in co-operation with the "ONE in FIVE" campaign. In my speech I presented the Hellenic model of "ONE in FIVE" campaign.

Finally, at the extraordinary meeting of the Network in Geneva, I am presenting to my fellow colleagues all my initiatives up to date in the framework of preventing child sexual abuse in Greece. It is my objective to work closely with all the members of the Network on common actions. The struggle to end child sexual abuse is a cause I am committed to and it is our common struggle.

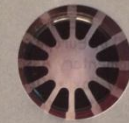
