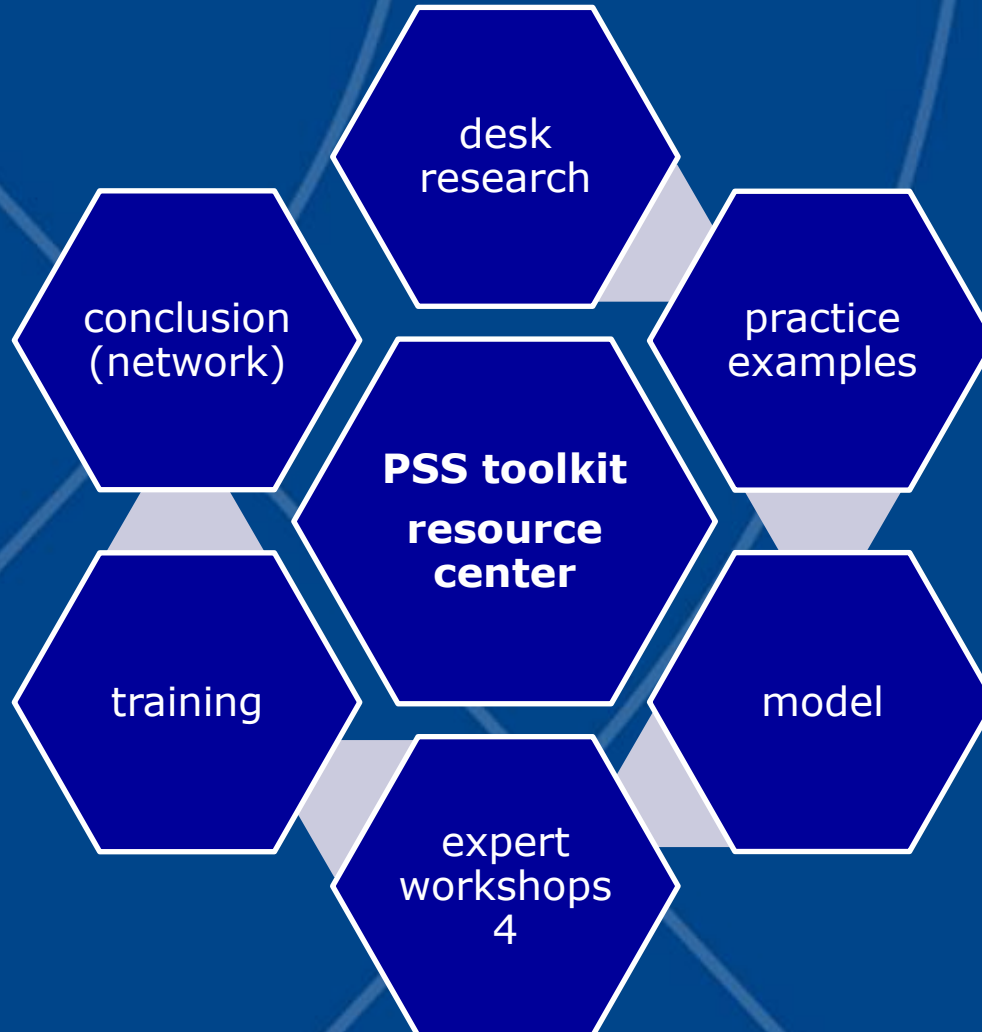
PSS objectives 1/2

-  raise awareness on safety and health issues among the athletes' entourage
-  assess the organisational capacity of relevant organisations to deal with the physical and moral integrity of young athletes (self-assessment tool)

PSS objectives 2/2

-  provide guidance on health and safety measures (health and safety training programme)
-  organise a virtual resource centre for the athletes and his/ her entourage on Pro Safe Sport for Young Athletes
-  call upon the already networking organisations to formally establish a network.
