






Distribution Maps Russia

- **Option 1:** Follow entirely the present Art. 17 and Art. 12 reporting guidelines and implement them by 2018
- Option 2: develop a reporting standard on the implementation of the Emerald Network (cfr. N2000 in 2004, mainly administrative issues)
- **Option 3:** select option 2, but in addition option 1 on a <u>selection</u> of species and/or habitats to be well prepared for the next reporting round, which might include a full reporting cicle.
